

FAYETTE COUNTY YOUTH SOCCER LEAGUE, INC.
CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS
PART I – CONSTITUTION

- ARTICLE I** NAME – This body shall be known as the Fayette County Youth Soccer League, Inc.
- ARTICLE II** PURPOSE – The purpose for which this league is organized is to coordinate the development of activities relating to the sport of soccer within Fayette County.
- ARTICLE III** COORDINATION – In the interest of promoting soccer, this league will coordinate and work closely with other groups involved in youth soccer activities within, but not limited to the Fayette County area.
- ARTICLE IV** AFFILIATION – This league is affiliated with and is a member of the Fayette County Recreation Commission and the Georgia Youth Soccer Association.
- ARTICLE V** MEMBERSHIP – Membership in the Fayette County Youth Soccer League is open to any soccer players and their parents or legal guardians, coaches, trainers, managers, administrators and officers participating in any program sponsored by the Fayette County Youth Soccer League.
- ARTICLE VI** VOTING MEMBERSHIP – Voting Membership in the Fayette County Youth Soccer League is restricted to members who are parents or legal guardians of soccer players under the age of 18, who are Fayette County residents, who are currently registered and participating in any program sponsored and administered by FCYSL, who are in good standing and not currently subject to sanction under Article IV of the FCYSL Bylaws.
- ARTICLE VII**
Section 1 ADMINISTRATION - Fayette County Youth Soccer League shall be governed by its Constitution and by-laws, supplemented by the rules of the Georgia Youth Soccer Association, Inc. In the event of conflict, the pertinent state rule shall apply.
- Section 2** The Fayette County Youth Soccer League Board of Directors shall have the authority to make final decision on all matters of controversy as provided for in Articles V and VI of the bylaws.
- Section 3** The Fayette County Youth Soccer League and its Board of Directors shall have the authority to do that which it deems expedient in order to enforce the purpose for which this league was organized.
- ARTICLE VIII** AMENDMENTS – Amendments to this Constitution as defined in the Bylaws may be made at the annual and semi-annual League meetings.
